We are prayerfully seeking to fill the position of: Tech (AVL) Production Director

To serve Christ Community Church by providing leadership to the Tech Team and overseeing all technical assets utilized to facilitate the Ministers, Ministries and Missions of CCC. This would include AVL (Audio, Video and Lighting) and livestream production and support for weekly worship services and other church-sponsored events as scheduled or requested.

While expertise in audio, lighting, and video maintenance and production is vital for this position, the emphasis will also be placed on recruiting, equipping and empowering Tech Team members to develop their skills. Our goal is for the Tech Director to coordinate, orchestrate and trouble shoot. We need a talented self-starter who knows it is easier to coach a qualified team than to try and play every position on their own.

The Technical Director's ultimate goal is to ensure that services and events across all facilities and ministries are able to utilize technology efficiently, effectively and strategically in order to fulfill the mission and vision of CCC and enhance the experience of those attending.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Inventory, oversee and maintain all technical assets on campus (Audio, Video, Lighting, Livestreaming, etc.).
- Management of all AVL and control systems including ongoing maintenance as well as installing and integrating new equipment and technology.
- Develop and equip teams to operate AVL systems for rehearsals, weekend services, ministry gatherings, and church-sponsored events. This would also include concerts, weddings, funerals, etc.
- Assist with producing videos needed for announcements, special services, promotions, events, social media, etc.
- Conduct necessary training sessions with team members, volunteers, and staff.
- Supervise and assist with stage setup and management for rehearsal, services, and events.
- Setup and preprogram AVL in advance of services to include lighting scenes, FOH, monitor consoles, etc.
- Maintenance and upkeep of all AVL support computers, overhead projectors, iMacs, and peripherals.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Bachelor's degree in film, video production, digital media, telecommunications, or related field.
- Formal training, specifically in audio, video, lighting, and control systems disciplines.
- A minimum of 1-3 years of progressive work experience in video production, broadcast, live stream, and live show experience.

- Previous leadership experience in media production of worship services at a medium to large church.
 - 1 + years hands-on experience with operating and maintaining technology in a modern production environment.
 - Leadership experience in a technical role with worship services utilizing large format lighting and audio consoles.
 - Proficiency with mainstream production and support software (ProPresenter, Resi, Planning Center Online, WorshipTeam.com, Multitracks, Adobe Creative Suite, etc.).
 - Be a fully devoted Christ-follower and support the ministry of CCC and its leadership team
 - Have excellent verbal and written communication skill
 - Be a team player and a team builder with the ability to rally others around the ministry and mission of CCC
 - Demonstrate willingness to learn, develop professionally and be coachable
 - Possess the skills necessary to train and instruct volunteers and others
 - Be physically capable of lifting 50 lbs or more

- Experience working in organizational management, project management, volunteer management, and volunteer leadership development.
 - Prior training in child safety, first aid, and crowd management.
 - Competent working knowledge of Apple OS and ProPresenter software.
