We are prayerfully seeking to fill the position of Worship Director:

To serve Christ Community Church by providing leadership to the Worship Team(s) and overseeing all Worship Ministry assets utilized to facilitate the Ministers, Ministries and Missions of CCC. Must be able to minister to an ethnically diverse body of believers.

While expertise in music and worship production is vital for this position, the emphasis will also be placed on recruiting, equipping and empowering Worship Team members to develop their skills. We need a talented self-starter who knows it is easier to coach a qualified team than to try and play every position on their own.

The Worship Director's ultimate goal is to ensure that services and events across all facilities and ministries are able to utilize excellent, diverse worship that serves to facilitate the mission and vision of CCC and enhance the experience of those attending.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Supervise all Church-wide Worship Ministries:

- Recruit, build, train, support, and champion a robust team of Musicians, Singers, Technicians, and Administrators.
- Promote the vision and provide training for the passionate love of God in our congregation.
- Create and maintain the annual calendar and strategic plan for Worship Ministries.
- Create and manage the annual Ministry Funding for Worship Ministries
- Develop and Train the Communion Team Leaders and Volunteers.
- Oversee the inventory and maintenance of all church-wide Worship Ministry equipment and software.
- Provide consultation, coaching, and development for all other Worship activities at CCC (Children's, Youth, Young Adults, ManSchool, Celebrate Recovery, et al.).
- Work with the Tech Production Director to develop long and short-term strategies for media development and growth associated with technical assets, team building and ministry funding needs.
- Responsible for broadcast compliance and necessary licensing (CCLI, video licensing, etc.)
- Maintain all AVL support accounts (Apple Music, Spotify, Multitracks, Resi, ProPresenter, DropBox, etc.)

2. Serve on the River Ministries Equipping Team:

- Meet periodically with the River & Family Equipping Teams to facilitate strategic planning, ministry collaboration, mutual encouragement, and prayer.
- Support the Pastor of Leadership Development by participating in CCC's ministerial development programs. This could involve providing supervision for one or more ministerial interns/residents.

3. Serve on the Teaching Team:

- Participate as a member of the Teaching Team to creatively contribute to and facilitate the worship service vision and related production plans.
- Attendance at any scheduled or called Staff meetings would also be expected.
- Participate in the local, regional, and national gatherings of the Free Methodist denomination.

4. Other duties as required or assigned.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Education: Bachelor's degree (or equivalent) in Music, Music Performance or related area.
- Advanced skillset would include: singing, proficiency with piano, guitar and other instruments as well as advanced knowledge and experience with medium to large venue AVL (Audio, Video and Lighting).
- Must have experience with leading worship, praying, speaking, providing cohesive transitions and direct support for the Message of the day.
- Experience: Served in a similar role at a church of 500+ for 2+ years, or equivalent experience in a para-church, missions, or non-profit organization of similar size.
- Competent working knowledge of Planning Center software, Apple OS and ProPresenter Software.
- Willing and able to uphold and foster CCC's Mission, Core Values, and Operational Values as described in the CCC Employee Handbook.

PREFERRED CHARACTERISTICS & SKILLS:

- Ordained Elder in the Free Methodist Church (or in process).
- Experience working in organizational management, project management, volunteer management, and volunteer leadership development.
- Prior training in child safety, first aid, and crowd management.
- Has a working knowledge of Planning Center Online or similar church database management software.
