We will receive intern applications through February 4, 2019. Interviews (skype or in-person) will be scheduled between February 11 – 28, 2019. Final decisions will be made by March 8, 2019.

Please note that the internship period begins Wednesday, May 29, 2019 and ends on Friday, July 26, 2019. We will select up to ten interns for the summer term. Interns must be high school graduates and no older than 24 years of age. All interns will be provided a small stipend for the eight weeks. The major gain, however, is the experience of working alongside a ministry staff in a large, healthy church. The eight weeks will include 20 – 25 hours a week. 7.5 hours will be meetings/training with Internship Director and intern team; 10 hours serving in specified ministry area; 3 – 7 hours general office hours with ministry supervisor. Any field trips and specific ministry trips/events will be paid for by internship program. Each intern will complete an assigned project during the term. 2019 CCC Summer Intern Ministry Descriptions

- **Kingdom Kids/Children's Ministry (2):** Assist the Children's Director with Sunday mornings; and work with volunteers and junior assistants. Project: Assist in planning and implementing a summer ministry program for CCC children and a training program for the Kingdom Kids junior assistants.
- **Worship Ministry (2):** Assist in planning worship services; prep for rehearsals, including tech; learn more about worship and worship ministry; conduct equipment inventory and maintenance. Project: Plan and execute a Night of Worship or a Worship Clinic.
- **Youth/Student Ministry (2):** Assist in preaching, teaching, and developing worship services; learn how to lead meetings and plan events and trips. Project: Assist in planning one Big Event – mission trip, camp or retreat.
- **Live Ministry – Outreach/Missions (1):** Gain general understanding of Live ministries philosophy and values along with general church systems, communications and team leadership. Assist in administering the Summer outreach plan. Project 1: plan and execute an outreach in our community. Project 2: Help with the initial planning and development process for the Christmas Missions Big Event for CCC and the Columbus Community.
- **Serve Ministry (1):** Primarily focus on First Impressions/Hospitality to include Face Team and all things related to the Sunday Morning guest experience; and also consider creative ways to get more people connected and serving in ministry. Project: Create a "best practices" manual for First Impressions/Biblical hospitality to share with member of FACE team and with all of CCC.
- **Communications Ministry (1): Become a passionate story teller for the Kingdom of God:** Learn and gain in experience in print design, social media communications, written communications, graphic design, web, photography and video production; and gain an understanding of the ministry of communications. Project: create an advertising campaign for the internship program. This would involve all elements of print design, photography, video production, written communication and social media content creation in an effort to promote the internship program for the next year. This will be the key focus throughout the summer.
- **General Church/Leadership Development Intern (1):** Learn and gain experience in all the ministry areas of the church including pastoral care, teaching team, administration, and community groups; and gain an understanding of the importance of leadership development as it applies to developing staff, building and training teams, creating levels of leadership, and organizational development. Project: assist in developing training modules for different ministry areas and leadership levels.
